City of Barberton COVID-19 Small Business Emergency Relief Grant Program

FAQ

- Q. Does the business need to be located in the City of Barberton?
- A. Yes, to qualify for assistance the business must be located in the City of Barberton and registered with the State of Ohio. 50% of the employees must be permanent residents of Summit County.
- Q. Does the business need to have been established for a specific length of time? A. Yes, the business must have been established for at least 12 months as of March 15, 2020.
- Q. Is the business eligible for this grant if other federal funding has already been obtain such as: SBA Loan, Grant from the Greater Akron Chamber or Payroll Protection?
- A. If the business has received any other federal funding they are not eligible for CDBG-CV funding.
- Q. Can the business be a non-profit?
- A. No non-profits are not eligible.
- Q. Can the business be a home based business?
- A. No at this time home based businesses are not eligible.
- Q. How much funding is available?
- A. The total amount of funding available is \$200,000. \$100,000 has been set aside for businesses with 2-25 employees and \$100,000 set aside for businesses with less than 2 employees.
- Q. Can a business be in bankruptcy or delinquent on taxes?
- A. No a business cannot be in bankruptcy and must be current on all taxes.
